
















Chords:

"7" Chords in the Key of C, Open Position

As we may have already discussed, basic major, minor, diminished, and augmented chords consist of 3 notes placed one space or line apart. Seventh chords are 4 notes all placed one space or line apart. The seventh is the first extension of the basic chord.

Note that you can use any of these chords to substitute for basic chords in the key of C, and add some character.
